

West Shore Bureau of Fire Commission
Meeting Minutes
September 11, 2017

President Dennis McGee called the monthly meeting of the West Shore Bureau of Fire Commission to order at 6:00 pm. The following members were present:

The first item of business was the approval of the minutes from the August 14, 2017 meeting. Dave Beasley made a motion to approve the minutes. Jon Powers seconded the motion. The motion passed 4-0.

The next item of business was Firefighters and Visitors. There was no audience.

The third item of business was the presentation of the financial reports and payment of bills. Jon Powers read the August financial report and made a motion to approve the financial reports and to pay the bills, Warren Stumpf seconded the motion. The motion passed 4-0.

The next item of business was the Commissioner's report as follows .In Commissioner Shadle's absence there was no report.

The fifth item of business was a discussion on the new building. Dennis McGee presented the Cumberland County resolution recognizing the new station efforts. Dennis also reminded members that there are bi-weekly construction progress meetings with Pyramid and the relevant trades that are working during that phase of construction.

The next item of business was Commission member comments. Dennis indicated that Lemoyne has a copy of Wormleysburg's ordinance providing property tax relief for firefighters and that their solicitor is reviewing it. Dave Beasley stated that Grace Methodist Church has requested a reply to their letter in which they communicated that they are not interested in the 326 Herman Avenue property. They noted that they want the Commission to indicate, in writing, our asking price for the property. After discussion members present agreed that we should not provide this information and when we hire a realtor that person can communicate on our behalf as they see fit.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:20 pm.
