CALL TO ORDER:

The Monthly Business Meeting of the West Shore Regional Police Department Commission was held at 510 Herman Ave, Lemoyne, PA and called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chairman Martini with Solicitor Deluce leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Motion:

Commissioner Candioto made a motion to approve the Minutes of the May 9, 2018 Monthly Business Meeting that were previously distributed, seconded by Commissioner Preble. The motion passed unanimously.

CITIZENS/VISITORS:

Lieutenant Friel, Officer Stolley, Officer Conroy, Officer Mauchamer and Officer Stambaugh and family were present. Lemoyne resident, Bob Huggler was also present.

CHAIRMAN’S ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Chairman Martini asked Chief Hope about National Night Out and if any assistance was needed. Chairman Martini reported to the citizens/visitors that the annual National Night Out event will be held at the Greek Orthodox Church in Camp Hill, Wormleysburg Borough.

TREASURER’S REPORT:

Commissioner Preble reported balances of \$431,401.21 in the checking account, \$129,679.57 in the Capital Reserve Fund, \$16,065.26 in the donation checking account and \$19,566.09 in the K9 donation account as of May 31, 2018. Commissioner Preble also reported a balance of \$150,505.35 in the Centric Capital Reserve Fund as of May 31, 2018.

Motion:

Commissioner Preble made a motion to approve the May 2018 Treasurer’s Report and to submit it for audit, seconded by Commissioner Candioto. The motion passed unanimously.

Chief Hope explained to the Commission that he sent the Draft Audit to them via email and asked that they review it and if they see any issues to report it to him so that he can correct them with the auditor.

Chief Hope requested permission to purchase two mobile radio units for the two new unmarked police vehicles.

Motion:

Commissioner Preble made a motion to allow Chief Hope to purchase two mobile radio units for the unmarked police vehicles for a total of \$9,400.00 with \$4700.00 coming from Major Equipment line item and \$4,700.00 coming from the donation account, seconded by Commissioner Gallo. The motion passed unanimously.

Officer Conroy reported for May that he and K9 Max had one K9 assist call outside of the jurisdiction and one K9 assist inside the jurisdiction. One call was for drugs and one call was for track/search. Officer Conroy and K9 Max also did seven foot patrols.

Officer Joshua Stambaugh was sworn in by Mayor Beasley and Mayor Preble.


ADJOURNMENT:
