CALL TO ORDER:

The Monthly Business Meeting of the West Shore Regional Police Department Commission was held at 510 Herman Ave, Lemoyne, PA and called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chairman Martini with the Commissioner Preble leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Motion:

Commissioner Beasley made a motion to approve the Minutes of the April 7, 2021 Monthly Business Meeting that were previously distributed, seconded by Commissioner Rothman. The motion passed unanimously.

CITIZENS/VISITORS:

Lt. Friel and Officers Conroy and Stolley were present for the meeting.

CHAIRMAN’S ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Chairman Martini discussed the ongoing Covid-19 restrictions and stated that they may be relaxed prior to the next Commission meeting. He also announced that there would be an Executive Session to discuss a Personnel issue and advised that there could be a vote afterwards.

TREASURER’S REPORT:

Commissioner Preble reported balances of \$821,343.00 in the checking account, \$10,547.39 in the donation checking account and \$13,354.40 in the K9 donation account as of April 30, 2021. Commissioner Preble also reported a balance of \$287,902.91 in the Capital Reserve Fund.

Motion:

Commissioner Preble made a motion to approve the April 2021 Treasurer’s Report and to submit it for audit, seconded by Commissioner Beasley. The motion passed unanimously.

Officer Conroy reported that he had 1 K-9 usage inside our jurisdictions, 3 K-9 usages to assist outside agencies, 2 training days, 1 PR assignment and 3 K-9 foot patrol details during the month of April.
