

WORMLEYSBURG BOROUGH COUNCIL'S STREETS, HIGHWAY AND  
SANITARY AFFAIRS COMMITTEE  
MINUTES  
JANUARY 18, 2019

The meeting was called to order at 8:20 am. by Chairman Deklinski with the following members present: Mr. Deklinski and Ms. Stuski; Mr. Kahler joined the meeting at 8:35 am. Also present were Mr. Berresford, Borough Manager, and Keith Straight, by telephone, our engineer.

The committee reviewed the 2018 Street Program, the south bound lane of Yverdon Drive, with the engineer. The committee wishes to see better traffic control than we had last year. And the work to be done after the school year. Motion by Mr. Kahler, seconded by Ms. Stuski, to have the engineer start the work to go to bid. Motion carried unanimously.

The Committee reviewed the continuation of the Walnut Street Storm Sewer Project. The engineer stated the following task need to be completed: 1) UGI needs to do their test borings after we meet with them; 2) Council needs to authorize doing this project; and 3) PA-American Water needs to relocate their lines; after renewing their Penn Dot Permit. The construction is estimated at \$40,000.00; the engineering is estimated at \$5,000.00; and the UGI test borings at estimated at \$2,000.00. Motion by Ms. Stuski, seconded by Mr. Kahler, to recommend Council proceed with this project asap. Motion carried unanimously.

**At this point the engineer left the meeting.**

The Committee reviewed the leaf pickup program. There was discussion about length of time we pick leaves, contractors taking advantage of us by having us haul leaves that they should haul away, etc. The committee asked Mr. Berresford to have COG survey their members about their leaf pickup practices.

Ms. Stuski asked Mr. Berresford to check with the solicitor about several items regarding The Woods At Waterford. 1) What is the developer's insurance deductible; 2) Is there insurance on the sub-contractors; 3) What is the insurance limits; and 4) How much is the bond. Mr. Berresford was also asked to have the excavator clean up the road at the end of each day.

The committee discussed a request for NO Parking on the north side of Chestnut Street from November 15<sup>th</sup> to March 15<sup>th</sup> each year. Motion by Ms. Stuski, seconded by Mr. Kahler, to recommend to Council approval of this request. Motion carried unanimously.

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The committee discussed the purchase of a new Ford F-550 dump truck with 4-wheel drive, aluminum bed with liner, plow and spreader from Stephenson's equipment through the C0Stars Program. The estimated cost is \$85,325.00. Delivery would be in four (4) weeks from date of order. Motion by Ms. Stuski, seconded by Mr. Kahler, to recommend to Council purchase of this truck. Motion carried unanimously.

The committee discussed the request to install a 4-way stop at the intersection of Ferry and 2<sup>nd</sup> Streets. Motion by Mr. Kahler, seconded by Ms. Stuski to recommend to Council approving this request. Motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 10:00 am.
