**CALL TO ORDER:**

The Monthly Business Meeting of the West Shore Regional Police Department Commission was held at 510 Herman Ave, Lemoyne, PA and called to order at 5:00 p.m. by Chairman Martini with Solicitor Deluce leading the Pledge of Allegiance.

**TREASURER’S REPORT:**

Commissioner Preble reported balances of \$650,252.86 in the checking account, \$7,532.25 in the donation checking account and \$18,870.69 in the K9 donation account as of June 30, 2019. Commissioner Preble also reported a balance of \$283,894.20 in the Centric Capital Reserve Fund as of June 30, 2019

**Motion:**

Commissioner Preble made a motion to approve the June 2019 Treasurer’s Report and to submit it for audit, seconded by Commissioner Panko. The motion passed unanimously.
